



SAFETY RULES

Safety must be given foremost consideration at all times by all members, at any location.

1. Shooting will cease immediately on the blast of the Field Captains whistle or by the cry of 'FAST!' from anyone.
2. No person may shoot until he/she are members of the club and the GNAS or have applied for the membership or are supervised by a senior GNAS member of at least 2 years experience.
3. The Field Captain or in his/her absence a committee member or any other person acting as field captain shall at all times when shooting takes place be in complete control and his/her decision is final in all matters.
4. A loaded bow **must not be drawn** except on the shooting line and then only in the **direction of the target**.
5. A loaded bow **must not** be drawn in an overhead position under any circumstances.
6. No archer is to shoot on their own.
7. Members other than those actually shooting or moving to and from the shooting line must be at least 5 yards behind the shooting line for outdoor shooting and for indoor shooting a distance of not less than 10 feet from the shooting line.
8. The club committee have available a first aid kit located in the front of the container.
9. Junior members – The club will not accept juniors under the age of 10. Juniors over 10 will only be accepted if a parent/guardian agrees to be present and responsible at all times.
10. Members must adhere to the site speed limit (currently 10mph).
